A special thank you to the eighth grade students who gave up a Friday night to help. Your presence was much appreciated.

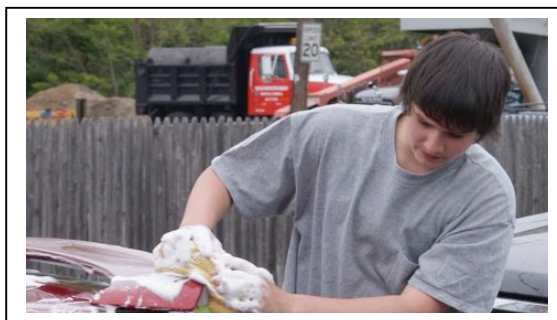
